Applied Behavior Analysts Member	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Qualified for certification to practice as a Board Certified Behavior Analyst in Nebraska and shall maintain this certification while serving as a board member. Must be certified in Nebraska by December 1, 2024. 2. Actively engaged in the practice of applied behavior analysis for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain such practice while serving as a board member. Active practice means devoting a substantial portion of time to rendering professional services. 3. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and shall remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member.
Applied Behavior Analyst Assistant Member	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Active certification to practice as a Board Certified Applied Behavior Analyst Assistant in Nebraska and shall maintain this certification while serving as a board member. Must be certified in Nebraska by December 1, 2024. 2. Actively engaged in the practice of applied behavior analysis for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain such practice while serving as a board member. Active practice means devoting a substantial portion of time to rendering professional services. 3. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and shall remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member.
Public Member	<p>At the time of appointment and while serving as a public member, an individual shall meet the following requirements.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member. 2. At least nineteen (19) years of age. 3. Represent the interests and viewpoints of the public. 4. SHALL NOT hold an active credential in any profession or business which is subject to the Uniform Credentialing Act, issued in Nebraska or in any other jurisdiction, at any time during the five (5) years prior to appointment. 5. SHALL NOT be eligible for appointment to a board which regulates a profession or business in which that person has ever held a credential. 6. SHALL NOT be or not have been, at any time during the year prior to appointment, an employee of a member of a profession credentialed by the department, of a facility credentialed pursuant to the Health Care Facility Licensure Act, or of a business credentialed pursuant to the Uniform Credentialing Act 7. SHALL NOT be the parent, child, spouse, or household member of any person presently regulated by the board to which the appointment is being made. 8. SHALL HAVE NO material financial interest in the profession or business regulated by this board. 9. SHALL NOT be a member or employee of the legislative or judicial branch of state government.
