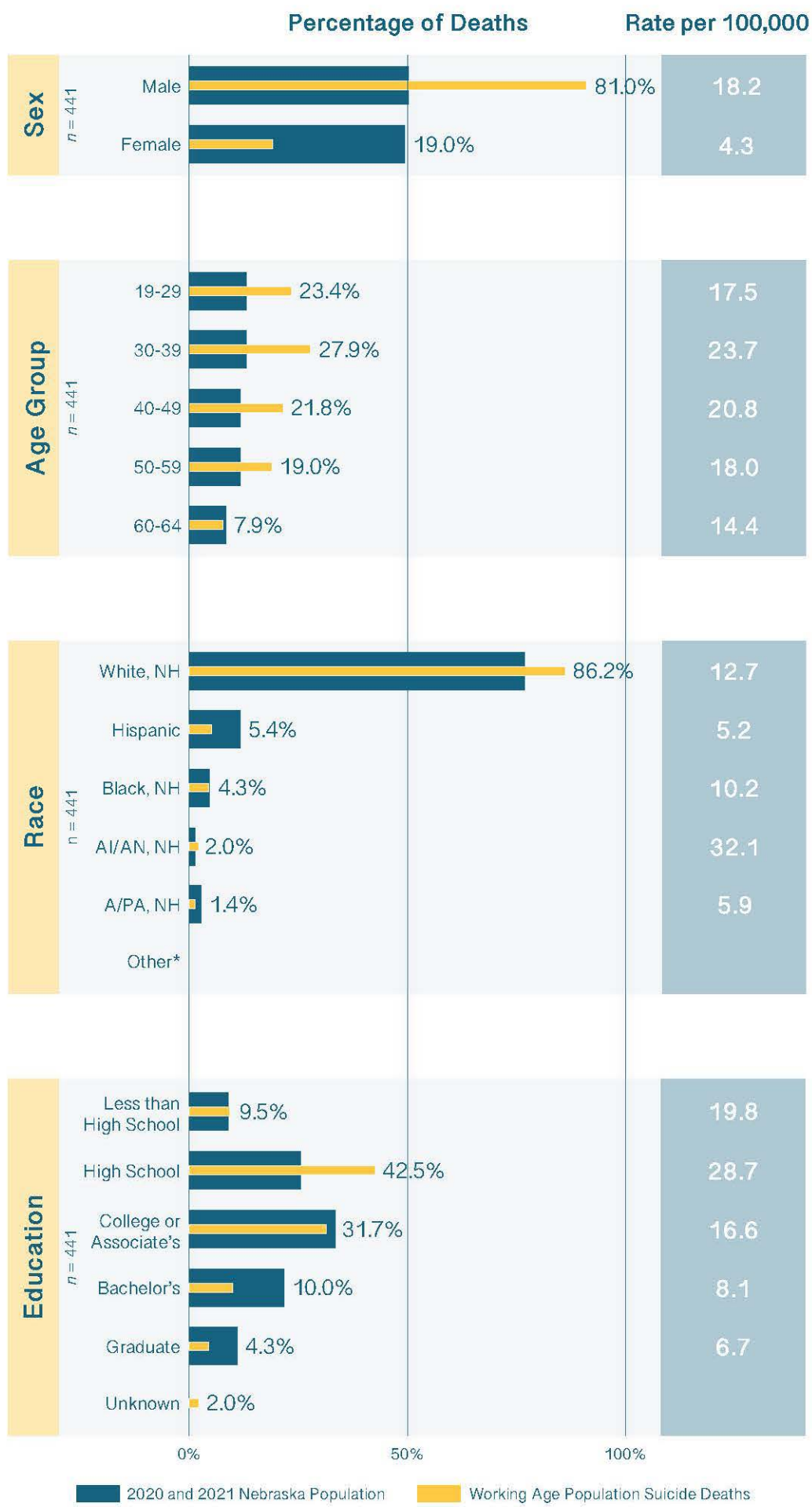


**Summary of Working Age Population Suicide Deaths in Nebraska**

441 Total Deaths (11.3 per 100,000 Population)

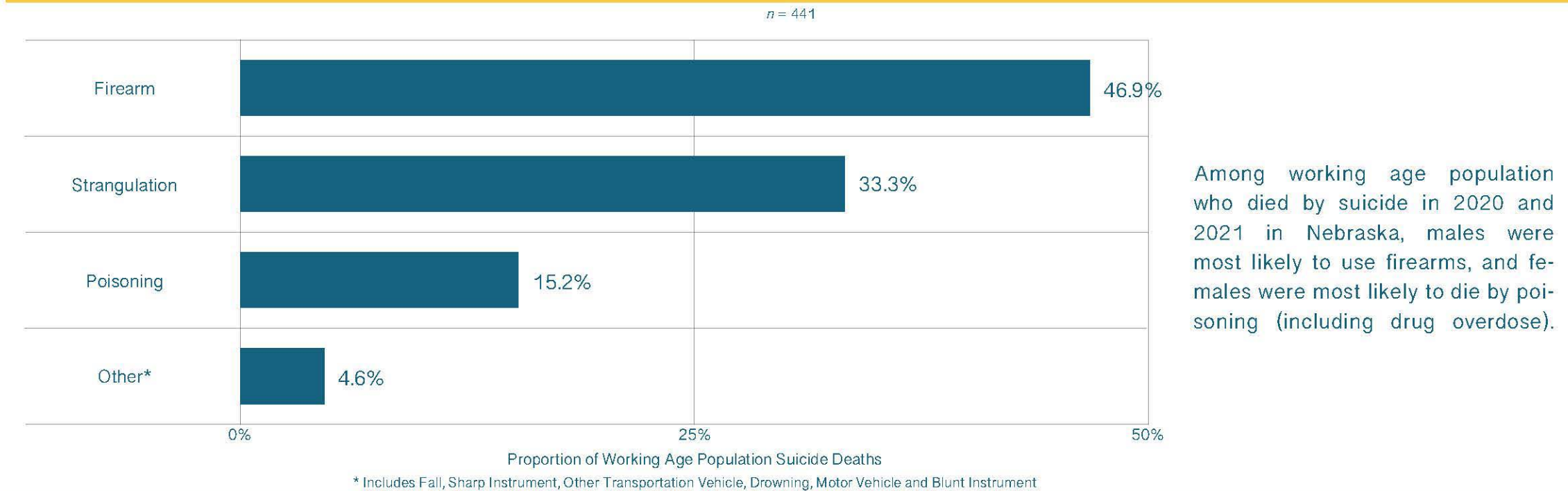
**Demographic Information**



AI/AN, NH: American Indian/Alaskan Native, non-Hispanic. A/PA, NH: Asian or Pacific Islander, non-Hispanic.

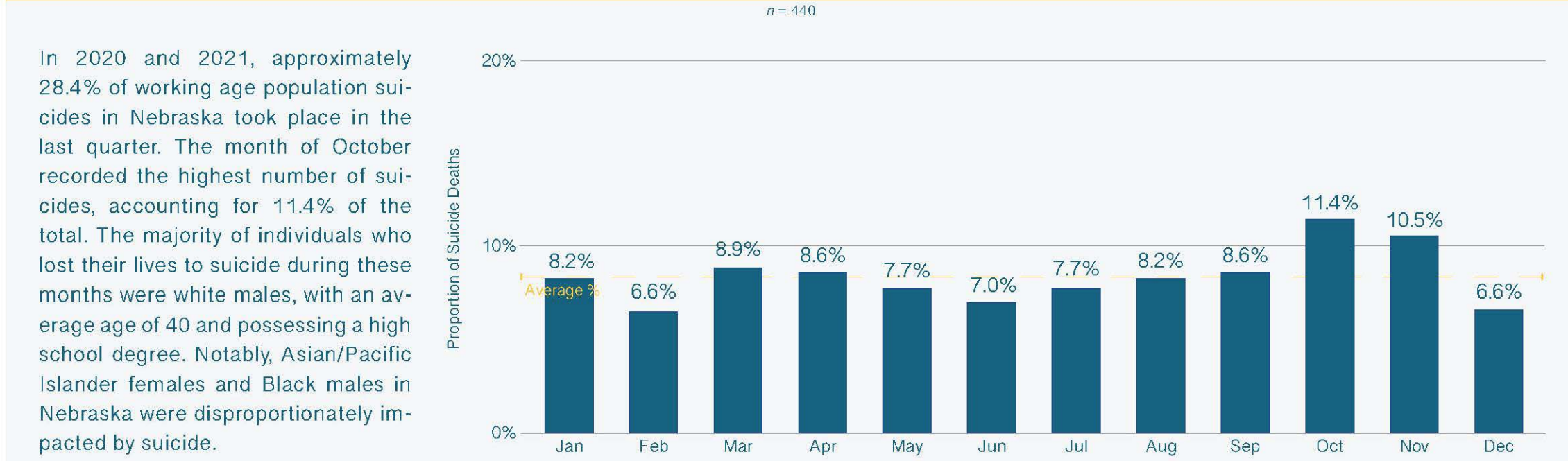
In 2020 and 2021, among working age individuals, white males with a high school education and between the age of 30-39 years old most frequently died from suicide. American Indian/Alaska Native and Hispanic males were disproportionately impacted by suicide in Nebraska.

**Cause of Death**



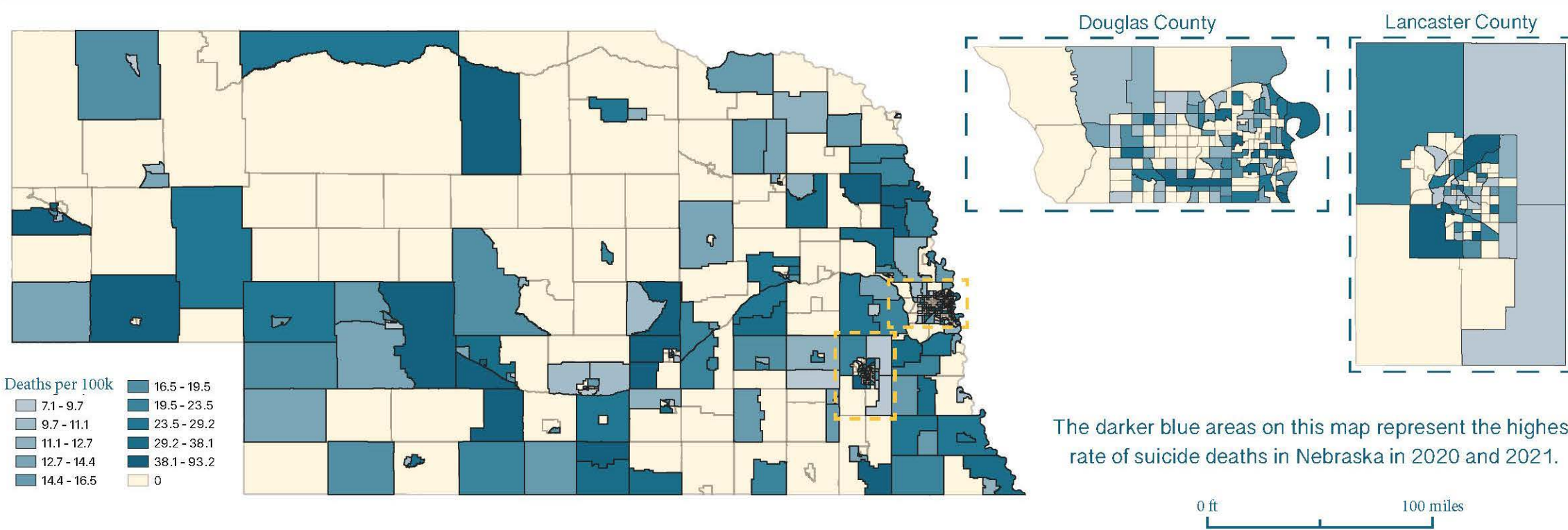
Among working age population who died by suicide in 2020 and 2021 in Nebraska, males were most likely to use firearms, and females were most likely to die by poisoning (including drug overdose).

**Suicide Deaths by Month**



In 2020 and 2021, approximately 28.4% of working age population suicides in Nebraska took place in the last quarter. The month of October recorded the highest number of suicides, accounting for 11.4% of the total. The majority of individuals who lost their lives to suicide during these months were white males, with an average age of 40 and possessing a high school degree. Notably, Asian/Pacific Islander females and Black males in Nebraska were disproportionately impacted by suicide.
