2024 Managed Care Organizations Contracts

The Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services has signed contracts with Molina Healthcare, Nebraska Total Care, and United Healthcare to provide services (including dental services) for the upcoming contract term. This new contract term for Medicaid's managed care program – Heritage Health – begins January 1, 2024.

Beginning January 2024, our managed care organizations, Molina Healthcare, Nebraska Total Care, and UnitedHealthcare will be providing dental services. Our MCO dental representatives may be reaching out to providers to contract for dental services.
