<p>Cervical cancer death rates are down by more than 50% over the past 40 years due mostly to increases in cervical cancer screening using Pap tests.          #ScreenOutCancer</p>
<p>Multicomponent interventions increase cervical cancer screening rates. Drive community demand and improve access while increasing provider delivery.          #ScreenOutCancer</p>
<p>To increase cervical cancer screening rates try 2 or more of these strategies: increase community demand, access and provider delivery. It's cost-effective!          #ScreenOutCancer</p>
<p>Send client reminders + offer alternative screening hours to increase cervical cancer screening rates.          #ScreenOutCancer</p>
<p>Provide incentives to your patients AND providers for higher cervical cancer screening rates!          #ScreenOutCancer</p>
<p>It's Cervical Cancer Prevention Month – what is keeping your patients from getting screened? Reduce barriers: offer transportation, childcare, and translation services.          #ScreenOutCancer</p>
